

Read from and write to a file, using while loop without using function. 8/27-28/2020

```
f = open("C:\\LSFT\\TXT\\weight-3.csv", encoding="utf-8")
```

```
i = 0
```

```
line = f.readline()
```

```
while line := f.readline(): # if not end of file
```

```
    sp = line.rsplit(",")
```

```
    x = sp[0]
```

```
    y = sp[1]
```

```
    print('x = ', x)
```

```
    print('y = ', y)
```

```
f2 = open("C:\\LSFT\\DAT\\weight.csv", "a") # note: use append mode "a", not the write mode "w"
```

```
f2.write(x) # if use "w", then only the last set of data will be written
```

```
f2.write(",") # write() argument must be string
```

```
f2.write(y)
```

```
i = i + 1
```

```
f2.close()
```

```
f.close()
```
